

# iS IT wORtH yOUr LiFe?

## 2 Corinthians 5:10-21

The greatest 'something' that you could ever give your life to is to personally trust in Jesus as Savior and Lord – and THEN make your life all about calling others to come to Christ and follow Christ.

### I. tWo pOWeRfUL mOTiVATiOnS

#### A. dEAtH

Verses 10-11 *For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil. Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, we persuade others.*

#### B. IOvE

Verses 14-15 *For the love of Christ controls us, because we have concluded this: that one has died for all, therefore all have died; and he died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for him who for their sake died and was raised.*

### II. tWO hUgE dIFfEReNcES

#### A. nEW eYeS

**Verse 16 (NIV)** *So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view.*

## **B. nEw pURpOsE**

**Verses 18-20** *All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; that is in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us.*

2. How are your eyes? What do you see when you see people?
